

**Privacy Policy** National Security Profiles, Inc. respects the privacy of personal information and understands the importance of keeping this information confidential and secure. We hold our privacy practices to a high standard to ensure that any information, whether it is a current customer or someone just browsing through the website, is kept private and secure.

**Information Collection** As you browse through nsprofiles.com, there is no personal information collected. You are anonymous as you browse. NSP will collect logging information such as what pages were viewed, what browser was used, and similar information to help build and update the website. No data related to the individual browsing the site is collected.

We treat personal information securely and confidentially. We limit access to personal information to only those persons who must have the information to provide our products or services to our customers. These persons are trained on the importance of safeguarding this information and must comply with internal security procedures and applicable law.
